Brian Howe is Honorary Professor in Social and Political Sciences at the University of Melbourne. He was Deputy Prime Minister of Australia (1991-95) and held a range of Ministerial portfolios, his administration of these being distinguished by major policy initiatives in Social Security reform of family payments, the introduction of Child Support, the National Mental Health Strategy and the Commonwealth Dental Scheme. He was also responsible for the Commonwealth State Disability Agreement and the Building Better Cities program.

Brian Howe is also a Uniting Church Minister. He will talk on some of the issues raised in a quote from the former Archbishop of Canterbury, Dr Rowan Williams:
