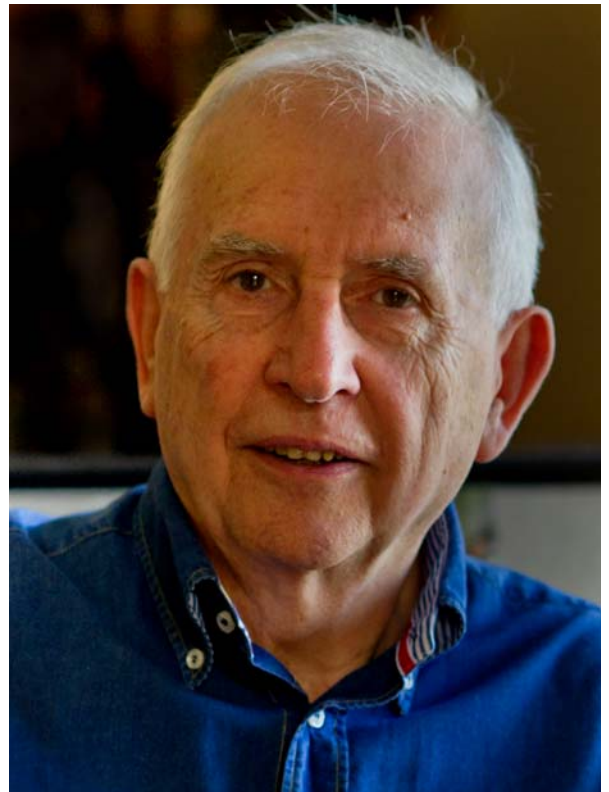
The Good Life: a community affair

Psychologist and social researcher

Hugh Mackay is currently honorary professor of social science at the University of Wollongong. A newspaper columnist for over 25 years, he is the author of nine books on social psychology and ethics. He was one of the founders of the St James Ethics Centre, a deputy chairman of the Australia Council and the inaugural chairman of the ACT Government's Community Inclusion Board.
