Ken Crispin, a retired barrister and Queen's Counsel, was the ACT Director of Public Prosecutions, a Supreme Court judge and president of the ACT Court of Appeal as well as the chair of the Bar Association.

He appeared for a number of high-profile defendants, including Lindy and Michael Chamberlain, and between 1996 and 2006 chaired the ACT Law Reform Commission.

In his spare time, Dr Crispin has completed a PhD in ethics, written numerous articles on law and ethics, three books, "*The Quest for Justice*" being a best seller, and the libretto for an opera.
