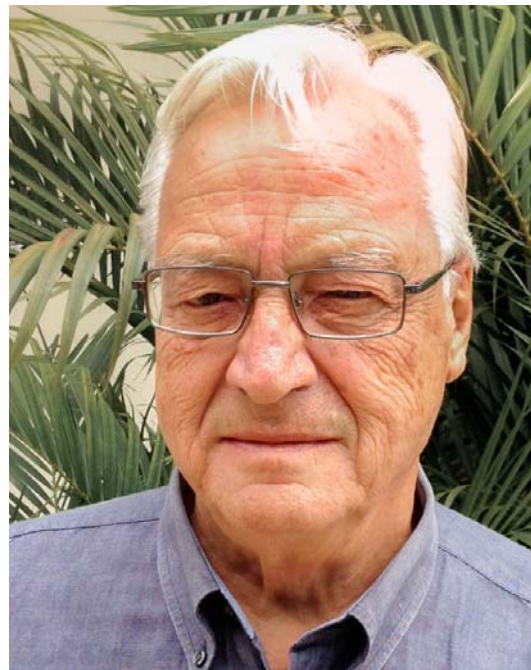
## Rev. Dr Thorwald Lorenzen
