



## Keynote Speaker: Professor Frank Stilwell

**Frank Stilwell** is Professor of Political Economy at the University of Sydney. He has been working at the University of Sydney ever since starting there as a Lecturer in Economics in 1970. He is the author of twelve books, including “*Who Gets What? Analysing Economic Inequality in Australia*”. He is co-ordinating editor of the Journal of Australian Political Economy. Frank is also renowned as a teacher and contributor to the media on economic issues. His continuing research interests include urban and regional development, critiques of mainstream economics, analysis of Australian economic policies, environmental policies and economic inequality.


## Other Speakers: Seminar: Land Rent- The Revenue that is not a Tax

**Dr. Terry Dwyer** graduated with honours in Arts and Economics from Sydney University and earned his PhD from Harvard University in the history of taxation theory. He has wide experience in advising on tax policy in the Australian Federal Treasury, Prime Minister’s Department and Economic Planning Advisory Council. He has advised Australian and international clients, including other governments. Terry has prepared submissions and papers for government, industry and academic institutions (eg. Henry Tax Review). **Richard Giles** is the Secretary of the Association for Good Government (NSW) and Editor of the association’s journal *Good Government*. **Who was Clyde Cameron? The Hon. Clyde R. Cameron (1913-2008)** started his working life as a rouseabout and shearer and rose to become arguably Australia’s greatest ever Minister for Labour as part of the Whitlam Labor Government from 1972-1975. Mr. Cameron was a great Australian statesman who truly understood political economy and who devoted his life to securing just rewards for Australian workers. A few months before he passed away, Mr Cameron stated his belief that there would soon be a mass resurgence of support in Australia for the principles and economic truths as enunciated by Henry George (1839-1897).
